

Br. DANIEL COXE

THE FATHER OF **NEW JERSEY FREEMASONRY**

Many of us have heard of the Daniel Coxe Medal for service which is awarded by our Grand Lodge, few of us, however, know this fascinating and influential Brother's biography.

Colonel Daniel Coxe (1673-1739) was

the son of Dr. Daniel Coxe, personal physician to Queen Anne. Dr. Coxe was titled to 1250 acres in New Jersey by King Charles II and also purchased the entire lower Mississippi valley, know then as the "Carolinas".



In 1701 his son, Col. Daniel Coxe came to Coxe Hall Creek near Cape May to watch over his father's lands. He then moved on to Burlington where he married a Quaker girl, Sarah Eckley, in 1707.

He served as commander of the Queen's forces in New Jersey, as a Justice of the Colonial Court and as a member of the Governor's Council.

Coxe proposed a union of all the continental colonies under one governor, although there would still be a lieutenantgovernor, representing the king in each. This was quoted many years later by W.B. Benjamin Franklin in his "Albany Plan".

His Mother Lodge was Devil's Tavern Lodge #8 in London. On June 5th, 1730 the Grand Lodge of England appointed him the Provincial Grand Master of New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania. He served until 1732.

He is buried in St. Mary's churchyard in Burlington.






